

Public Dental Care Electorate: Burwood



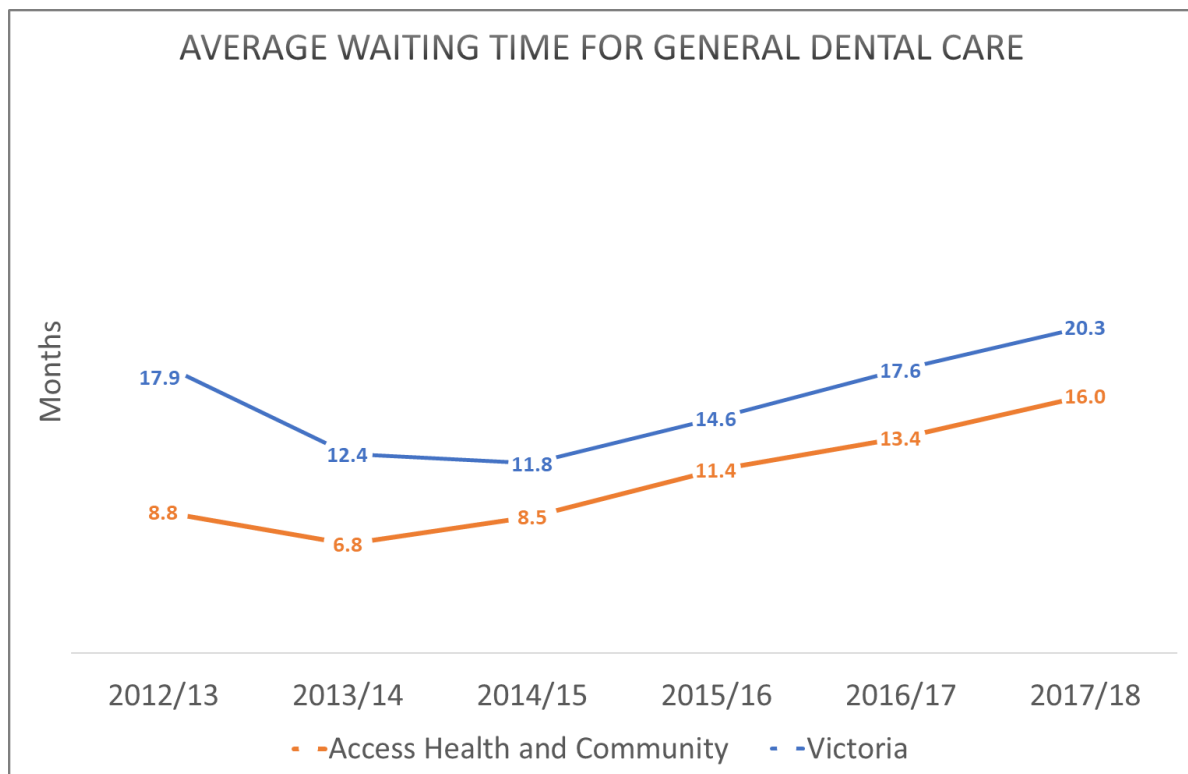
This fact sheet provides information on public dentistry for Victorian electorates, compared to the Victorian average.

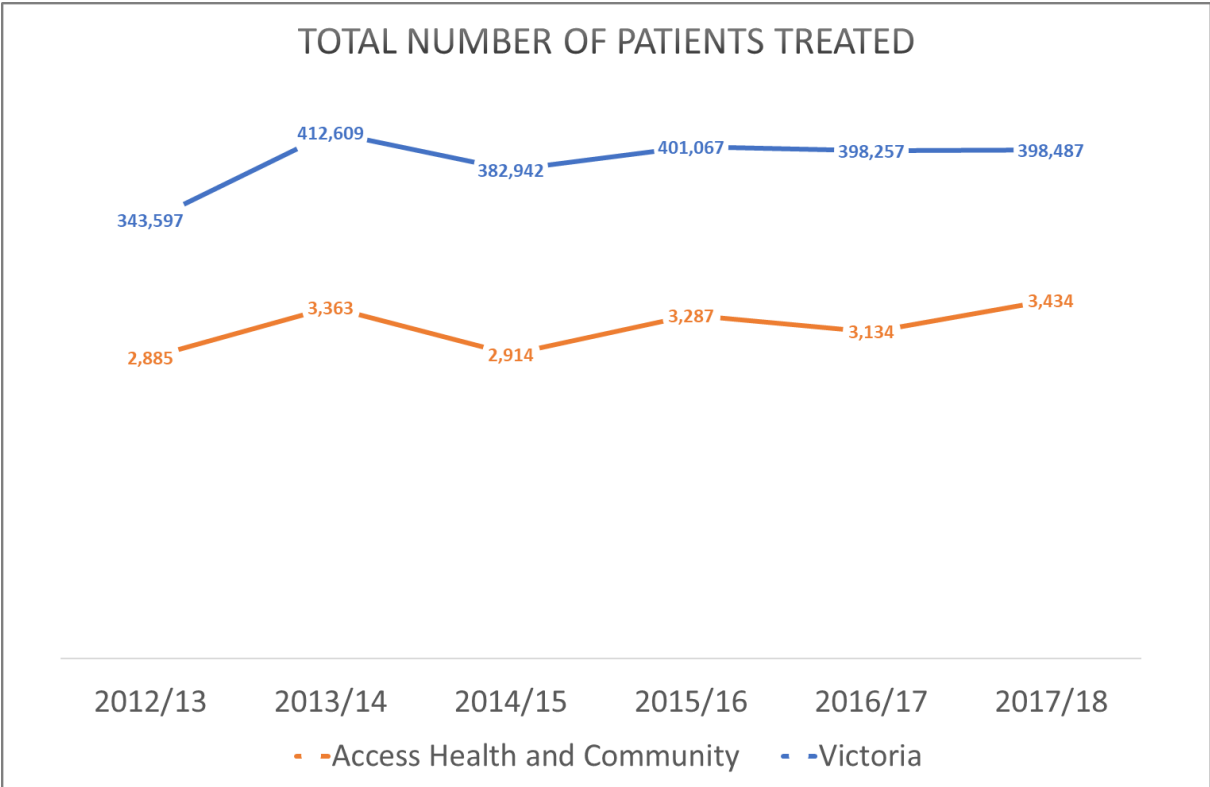
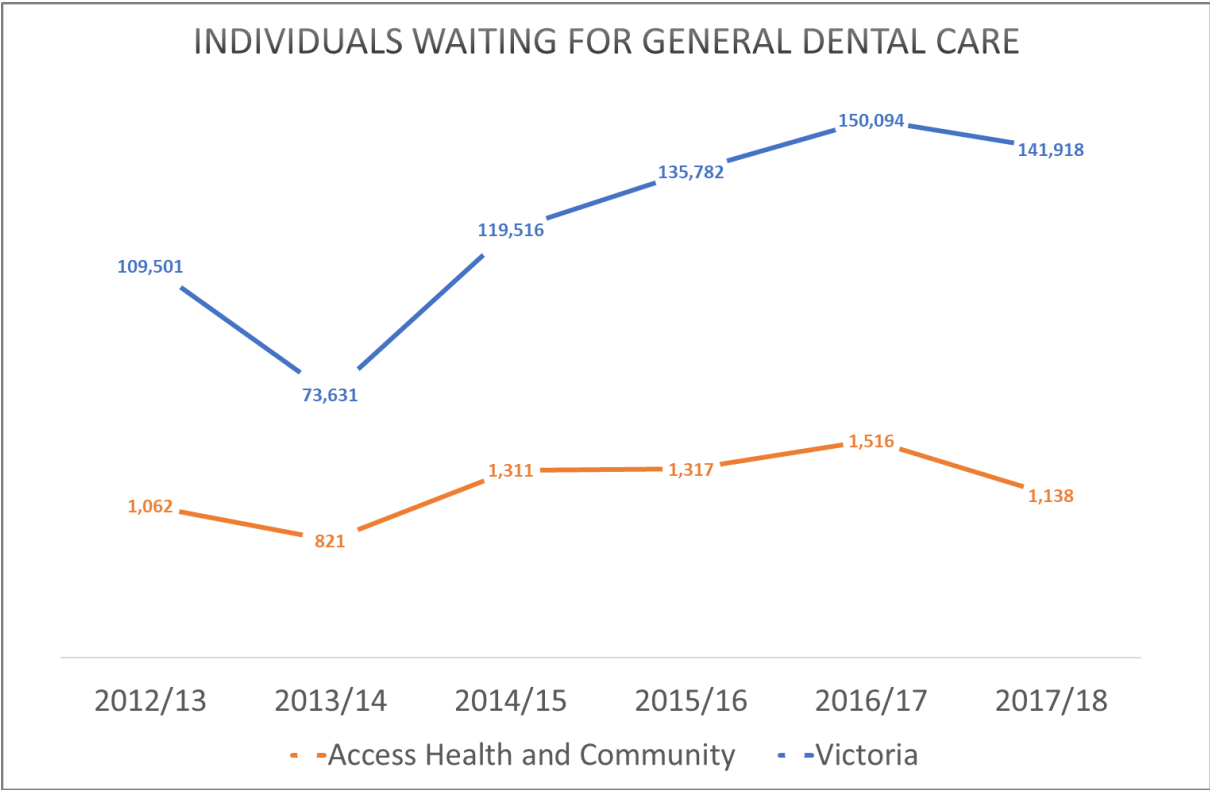
