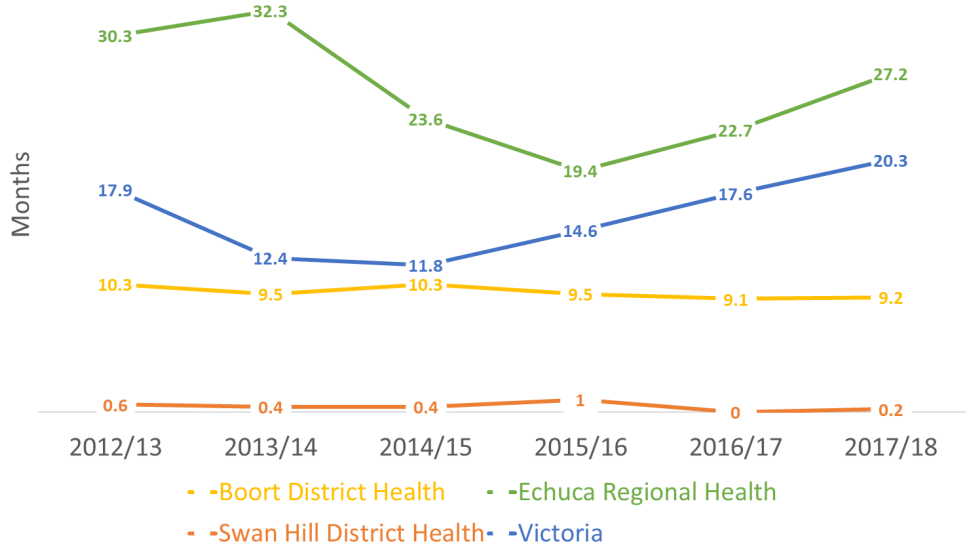

General dental care: routine care, including examination, cleaning, fillings, extractions, root canal treatment.

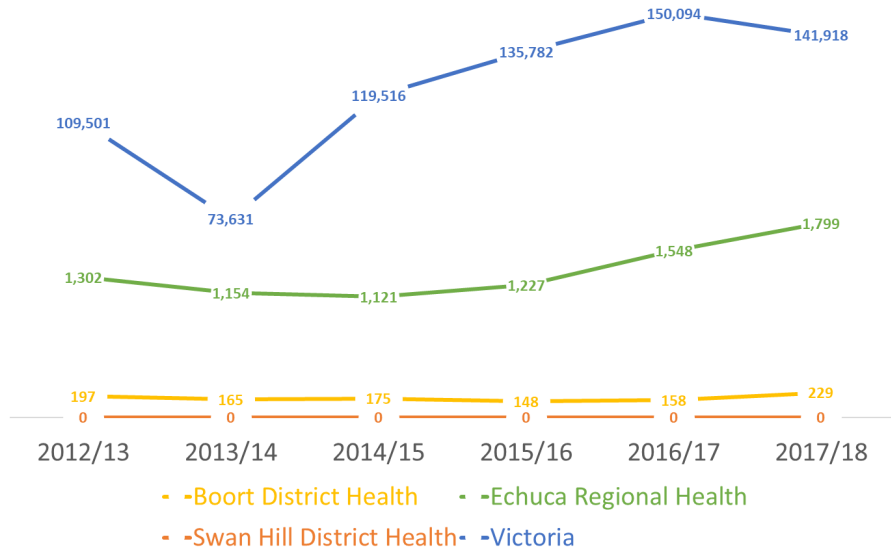
Denture care: routine provision of dentures.
