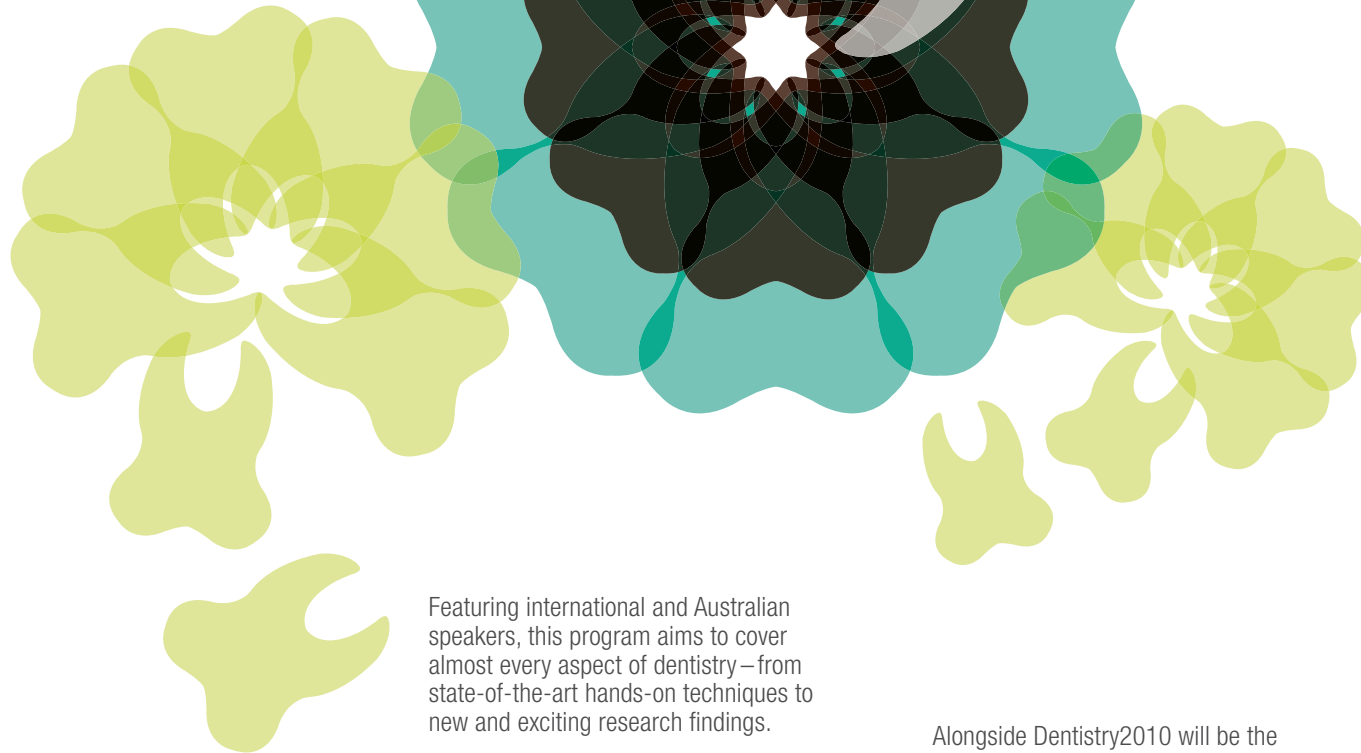




Dentistry2010
